

### Phillip Island Wildlife Park

Phillip Island Road, Cowes Ph: 5952 2038

Parking is available next to the Centre with a slight incline into the Visitor Centre. Entry doors push inwards, staff can assist if required. Wildlife viewing areas have ramps and handrails. Due to animal housing requirements (e.g.: goannas & echidnas), some displays have restricted viewing. Paths are compacted gravel & are wheelchair accessible. Kangaroos and wallabies are free range and can be handled by visitors. Indoor picnic area is fully accessible. A disabled toilet is provided.

### Rhyll Trout & Bush Tucker Farm

36 Rhyll-Newhaven Rd, Rhyll Ph: 5956 9255

The attraction is fully accessible. Ramp access to indoor lake and pathways leading to outdoor lakes. Vehicle access to outdoor lakes is also available upon request.

### State Coal Mine, Wonthaggi

Garden Street, Wonthaggi Ph: 5672 3053

A disabled parking bay is available near the entry to the complex. Ramp entry is provided to the Centre. Most above ground buildings are accessible to wheelchair users. Access to the underground tour is limited for wheelchair users, as mine entry & exit is via a skip, (please note skip not operational until Easter 2011) A disabled toilet is provided in the Centre.

### Warrook Cattle Farm

South Gippsland Hwy, Monomeith Ph: 5997 1321

Disabled parking is located at rear of restaurant, approx. 50m from the main entrance. Drop off point at Gift Shop, which has an accessible entry with wide doors. Entry is over level threshold and ramp, but no handrails. Inside and outside

disabled toilets provided. Limited access in restaurant can be managed to suit groups, table arrangements can be made to ensure easy access. Prior arrangement is encouraged.

### Wildlife Wonderland

Designated disabled car park 1 metre from front entrance. Wheelchair accessible pathways & ramp access to building. Front door is open during operating times. Wildlife viewing areas and Shop/Café area is wheelchair accessible. Disabled toilet provided. Clear signage throughout complex.

### **A Maze 'N Things**

Phillip Island Road, Cowes Ph: 5952 2283

Disabled parking is available approx. 25m from entry. Clear path on approach to entry to wide automatic doors. Café and toilets wheelchair accessible. Wheelchair access limited in Maze. Anti Gravity Room and some areas of Illusion Rooms and Puzzle Island is not wheelchair accessible. A wheelchair is available free of charge for visitors with limited mobility.

### **Churchill Island**

Phillip Island Tourist Rd, Newhaven Ph: 5956 7214

Two disabled parking bays are located 20m from Visitor Centre. Centre has level access with manual door opening outwards. A low counter provides easy access to staff. Disabled toilet provided in the Centre. The Visitor Centre, gardens and Amess Homestead (via the back veranda) are wheelchair accessible. Outdoor access to farm and homestead is varied with some areas being quite steep. Wheelchair available free of charge, for visitors with limited mobility. Easy to read signage provided throughout.

### **Heritage Centre**

Thompson Ave, Cowes 59569214 or 59568501

A disabled car park is located behind the Library (enter car park via Church St) or outside the Post Office in Thompson Ave. Clear approach to entry via automatic doors. The Centre is wheelchair accessible and a disabled toilet provided. Open Sat 10-12pm & Sun 2-4.30pm & during school holidays Tues & Thurs 2-4.30pm.

### **Koala Conservation Centre**

Phillip Island Tourist Rd, Cowes Ph: 5952 1307.

Four disabled parking bays are located outside

main entry approx. 100m from the Centre. Ramp leads to entry with wide electronic sliding doors, interior of Visitor Centre is fully wheelchair accessible. Koala viewing areas are wheelchair accessible along a series of boardwalks (gradient to 1:14). The paths to elevated boardwalks are compacted gravel. Disabled toilet provided in the Centre.

### **Maru Koala & Animal Park**

Bass Highway, Grantville Ph: 5678 8548

Disabled parking located 15m from main entry, accessible to wheelchairs along a level non-slip surface. Wildlife viewing areas and Café is wheelchair accessible. Walkways and ramps have handrails. A disabled toilet is provided.

### **National Vietnam Veterans Museum**

Veterans Drive Newhaven Ph: 5956 6400

There are two disabled car parks available, level access to building with inward opening door. All levels of the museum are accessible with the installation of a lift. Easy access toilet provided.

### **The Nobbies Centre**

Point Grant, Ventnor Ph: 5951 2800

Disabled parking is available close to the main entrance. The centre is fully accessible by a series of ramps.

### **Phillip Island Vineyard & Winery**

Berrys Beach Rd, Phillip Island Ph: 5956 8465

Parking is available next to the winery with a slight incline up crushed gravel driveway to the entry. Manual doors at the entrance open outwards. Wine tasting available in sunroom. Easy access toilet available, but no handrails.

### **Penguin Parade**

Ventnor Rd, Ventnor Ph: 5951 2800

Six disabled car parks located in Area I parking, approx. 60m from entry to Visitor Centre. The entry path is fully lit and has slip resistant pavers. Ramp access also provided. Wide manual doors for wheelchair access are left open during summer and at penguin parade viewing time. Disabled toilet provided in Centre. Displays visible from wheelchair height. Wheelchair available free of charge for visitors with limited mobility. A motorised buggy is available on request from Visitor Centre to viewing area. Ramps to viewing platforms have handrails with standing and seating areas.

### **Phillip Island Grand Prix Circuit Visitor**

#### **Centre**

Back Beach Road, Phillip Island Ph: 5952 9400

Disabled parking located 15m from entry. Access to main entry is on a level ground of gravel, concrete and brick paving, with automatic doors. The History of Motorsport display is accessible for wheelchair users. The self guided tour and Café (entry via the garden area) is accessible with assistance. The guided tour of the circuit is not wheelchair accessible. A disabled toilet is provided in the Centre.

### **Phillip Island Tenpin Bowling &**

#### **Entertainment Centre**

91 -97 Settlement Road, Cowes Ph: 5952 3977

Parking is available approx. 14m from the Centre. Concrete level path leads to entry. Double front doors can be opened during operating hours. Bowling is available for persons with a disability, with assistance from staff and carers as required. A disabled toilet is provided.
